


# Youth Risk Behavior Survey Data: Sexual Activity

- **24% of high school students have had sex in the past 3 months**
- **53% used birth control during last intercourse**




# YRBS Data: “Ever had sex” by Grade, 2011






# Chlamydia in 15-19 Y.O. Female Adolescents

# Sexual Identity – YRBS Data

- **9% of HS boys and 12% of HS girls identify themselves as other than heterosexual (gay, lesbian, bisexual or not sure)**
- **4% of HS boys and 8% of girls had same sex sexual contacts**

# Consequences

- **Early pregnancies, births**
  - **9% of births statewide are to women 15-19 years of age (~1500 births per year)**
- **STIs and their health consequences**
  - **Risks for pelvic inflammatory disease, infertility, and other serious conditions**
  - **1 in 4 sexually active adolescent females have an STI**
- **High rates of sexually transmitted infections**
