

**EXCEPTION REVIEW COMMITTEE - SCHOOL YEAR 2015-16

For Board Action – February 17, 2015**

2. Generic Requests – No BOE Action Required

BOE Policy 2412 establishes a category of "Generic Waiver and/or Exception" for which the Board has found "to have sufficient merit or be sufficiently routine so as to justify automatic approval upon application by a school." BOE Policy directs the Superintendent to "approve upon receipt, all requests from schools for such waivers or exceptions." It also requires that requests for exceptions to labor agreements be agreed to by the respective union.

Three schools submitted requests that fall in the "Generic Waiver and/or Exception" category. These requests were reviewed and approved by the Exception Review Committees, including the HSTA and HGEA representatives. These requests are approved without further Board action.
