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Basic Tripod Facts

- School Based Teams select classes to be surveyed according to schedules and minimum sample sizes (≥ 5 students)
- •K-12 teachers who are responsible for planning/delivering/assessing instruction will roster at least 1 class or group of students
- •Minimum teacher assignment and student enrollment is 4 weeks
- •Excluded: Students on HSA-Alt, who submit declination letters, or do not meet minimum enrollment



School Base teams consist of –Roster verification coordinator, Tech coordinators, Tripod survey coordinator, registrar or eSIS clerk, curriculum coordinator, and Principal

Survey Process

- Detailed survey administration instructions, protocol and script are provided to administrators and teachers
- State/Complex office, School, or vendor identify breaches in the survey process & investigate
- Completed surveys are placed in a sealed unlabeled white envelope to protect student confidentiality
- Schools are instructed to box up all the surveys and return to the vendor within 3 days after administration
- Reports are confidentially delivered from vendor to teachers, principals & CASs via email



High Completion Percentage

- Teachers Rostered: 9,660
- Teachers Survey Administration: 9,659



External variables:

- 1.Survey completion high percent completion
- 2.Differences in survey administration procedures thorough and regular access to Helpdesk
- 3.7 Breaches of protocol identified in over 9,000 surveys

Tripod

 Approximately 171,180 Students responded to part or all of the survey

Survey Level	Percent Student Completion	Number of Questions
Early Elementary (K-2)	99%	32/6 demographic
Elementary (3-5)	83%	60/8 demographic
Secondary (6-12)	96%	90/12 demographic
Grand Total	93%	




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Finally, to produce individual teacher reports, the survey vendor (Tripod/Cambridge Education) applies minimum response criteria as follows: a minimum of 5 students must complete the survey a minimum of 3 responses for each of the items within each of the Cs.

However, like favorability percentages, there are minimum criteria for producing NCE scores:

minimum 5 students must complete the survey at least one response on 1 any question within each of the Cs all responses are added to the calculation
