## Agenda Item IV.B, Committee Action on Committee reconsideration of Committee recommendation of Board approval of new Board Policy 204.12, Non-Educator Preparation Programs

Human Resources Committee March 17, 2015

Board Policy 204.12, Non-Educator Preparation Programs was presented at the Human Resources Committee's February 17, 2015 meeting. It was a new policy that was not originally part of the Board's existing body of policies. The Human Resources Committee reviewed the policy and at the February 17, 2015 General Business Meeting, made a recommendation to the Board of Education ("Board") that the policy be approved by the Board. The Board deferred action on Policy 204.12 to the next Board meeting pending further discussion with the Department.

The Human Resources Committee is now reconsidering its recommendation of approval of Board Policy 204.12. The policy that was proposed is on the following page.

## NON-EDUCATOR PREPARATION PROGRAMS

The placement and supervision in the public schools of student interns from non-educator preparation programs shall be conducted through programs that are approved in their home state and nationally accredited from a body recognized by the United States Department of Education to accredit such programs.
