## **Current Strategic Plan Target & Metric**

#### **Target 1BIII:**

Equity in Achievement

Increase proficiency of the lowest achieving student groups so that the percentage difference in test scores between highest and lowest achieving student groups is eliminated.

#### Metric:

The percentage of students who achieved at least the minimum necessary math growth to score above or stay above proficiency within four years or by eighth grade (whichever comes first).



### **Proposed Strategic Plan Target & Metrics**

#### **Rationale for change:**

✓ True equity measure ✓ Focus on gaps ✓ Alignment between Strat Plan & Strive HI

#### **Target 1BIII:**

*Equity in Achievement* Close proficiency gaps between High-Needs and Non-High-Needs so that the percentage difference in proficiency test scores between student groups is eliminated.

#### Metric: Current year gap rate


*(from Strive HI):* The gap rate between High-Needs\* and Non-High Needs Students

(Non-High Needs Students proficiency) – (High Needs Students proficiency)

\*High Needs Students: Title I, ELL, SPED

## Understanding "Gap" vs. "Gap Rate"



The GAP RATE differentiates between schools with equal GAPS but different PROFICIENCY RATES.

#### GAP :

(Non-High Needs Students proficiency) – (High Needs Students proficiency)

SCHOOL A = 30 pp

SCHOOL B = 30 pp

#### GAP RATE:

(Non-High Needs Students proficiency) – (High Needs Students proficiency)

(Non-High Needs Students proficiency)

SCHOOL A = 38%

SCHOOL B = 60%

# Gap Rate Options for Math, Reading, combined

#### Note:

Current year gap rate combines reading and math into one gap rate

**Options:** 

1.Complete alignment with Strive HI: combine

2.Separate current year gap rate for reading and math\*

\*on list for consideration for change to Strive HI for 14-15
