- Our goal this year is to encourage daily, on time school attendance.
- Academic success starting in kindergarten and continuing through high school is dependent on daily on time attendance.
- Families play a key role in making sure students get to school safely every day and understand why attendance is so important for success in school and in life.
- We realize some absences are unavoidable due to health problems or other circumstances. But, we also know that when students miss too much school regardless of the reason -it can cause them to fall behind academically. Your child is less likely to succeed if he or she is chronically absent.
- The Hawaii State Board of Education has defined chronic absenteeism as any student missing 15 or more days of school, excused or unexcused.

#### **Clearly going to school regularly matters!**

Here are a few practical tips to help support regular attendance:

- Make sure your children keep a regular bedtime and establish a morning routine including breakfast.
- For young children lay out clothes and pack backpacks the night before.
- Ensure your children go to school every day unless they are truly sick.
- Avoid scheduling vacations or doctor's appointments when school is in session.
- Talk to teachers and counselors for advice if your children feel anxious about going to school.
- Develop back up plans for getting your child to school if something comes up. Call on a family member, neighbor, or another parent to take your child to school. Set up a car pool.
- Leave early enough to account for traffic so your child gets to school on time.


