


## What is NAEP & how is it used?


- ✓ NAEP is a test given in all states, to a sample of students in grades 4 and 8.
- ✓ Variety of content areas, on a rotating basis.
- ✓ Used to review state and national performance over time.
- ✓ Compares performance across states.
- ✓ No school or student level data.
- ✓ Not connected to state or federal accountability.

Gains in the percent of students scoring proficient or higher




# A Decade of Significant Improvement




# Progress With Room For Improvement
