SUBJECT: Discussion/Recommendation for Board Action on the School Year (SY) 2015-2016

School Calendar

#### 1. RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Hawaii State Board of Education (Board) take action to adopt the attached proposed school calendar for use in SY 2015-2016 on the December 2, 2014 General Business Meeting, after discussion and support from the Student Achievement Committee on the same day.

#### 4. DISCUSSION

- a. Conditions leading to the recommendation
  - (i) The proposed calendar deviates from the model used last year. First, the proposed single school calendar, applicable to all public schools except multi-track schools and charter schools, reflects a Monday start date for students. This change is supported by an analysis of attendance data from the past four years, which showed that an additional 5,000 students were absent on the first day of school, when that day falls on a Friday versus a Monday. A similar trend continues throughout the school year, which is why the proposed calendar focuses on maintaining full, five-day, instructional weeks.
  - (ii) Second, the proposed calendar reinstates a two-week winter break in order to support student learning and to address scheduling the last day of school. Research suggests that students suffer learning loss during prolonged absences from school. In addition, shifting to a two-week break

means the last day of school for students falls before Memorial Day versus requiring students to return to school for 1-2 days after Memorial Day.

(iii)The proposed calendar meets the requirements of 180 days of student instruction pursuant to Act 167, as amended by Act 52, and codified in HRS §302A-251. It also maintains the 190 work days for teachers (189 actual work days plus one equivalent day [6 hours] contiguous to the work day).

b. Previous action of the Board on the same or similar matter

School calendars from previous years.

c. Other policies affected

None.

- d. Arguments in support of the recommendation
  - This change is supported by an analysis of attendance data from the past four years, which showed that an additional 5,000 students were absent on the first day of school, when that day falls on a Friday versus a Monday. A similar trend continues throughout the school year, which is why the proposed calendar focuses on maintaining full, five-day, instructional weeks.
  - The length of the semester days for students is balanced with 89 days in the first semester and 93 in the second semester, which is especially important for secondary schools that may have semester long classes.
  - The proposed calendar should not have a negative impact on summer school schedules.
  - Research supports shorter interruptions in learning to prevent learning loss.
  - The Department, through a Superintendent directed workgroup, is exploring options for starting the school year later in future years in order to avoid the very hot days in late July and early August. However, to do so will require extensive planning and analysis to address the many complicated personnel issues associated with making significant changes to the school calendar. For example, the current HSTA Agreement requires the 10-month teacher work year to end before Kamehameha Day. In addition, modification to the pay periods and the date upon when the first paycheck of the school year is received by 10-month employees may need to occur, in consultation with the unions, given the statutory requirement that all employees receive 24 pay checks reflecting 1/24<sup>th</sup> of annual salary over the course of the work year. Once the workgroup has completed its analysis and made recommendation, the Department will report to the Board with further suggestions.
- e. Arguments against the recommendation
  - Teachers may prefer a three-week winter break.

h. Possible reaction of the public, professional organizations, unions, Department of Education staff and/or others to the recommendations

HSTA provided proposed alternative recommendations to the proposed calendar. The most recent alternate is attached to this memo as an addendum. The Department is concerned that the HSTA proposal starts school for students mid-week, which the data demonstrate will result in increased student absences. The Department is also concerned that the lengthened vacations will contribute to learning loss.

HGEA has not provided comments at this time.

There are no known personnel implications. Hawaii Government Employees Association and HSTA have been provided copies of the recommended calendar. Consideration will be given to all issues, concerns and suggestions.
