

## Setting Aside Land for Public Purposes

By this Executive Order, I, the undersigned, Governor of the Territory of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority in me vested by paragraph q of Section 73 of the Hawaiian Organic Act, and every other authority me hereunto enabling, do hereby order that the public land hereinafter described be, and the same is, hereby set aside for the following public purposes:

**FOR the Holoalea Library Site to be under the control and management of the County of Hawaii for the use of its Managing Board of the Hawaii County Library.**

Being a portion of Lot 11 of the partition of the upper section of H.P. 4475, L.C. Award 7713, Apana 43 to V. Kemamalu, conveyed to the Territory of Hawaii by the County of Hawaii by deed dated October 27, 1953, and recorded in Liber 2756, pages 120-121. (Land Office Deed 11625)

Holoalea 1st and 2nd, North Kona, Hawaii, T. H.

Beginning at an "X" on stonewall at the southwest corner of this lot, and on the east side of Main Government Road (Maunaloa Highway), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "NORTH MERIDIAN" being 8780.2 feet South and 15585.8 feet East and running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:

1. 195° 03' 60.00 feet along the east side of Main Government Road (Maunaloa Highway) to an Iron Axle;
2. 270° 46' 100.00 feet to an "X" on rock;
3. 15° 03' 60.00 feet to an "X" on stonewall;
4. 90° 46' 100.00 feet to the point of beginning and containing an AREA OF 5810 SQUARE FEET.
