General Business Meeting

October 3, 2017

The Board of Education (“Board”) held three community meetings in September with the primary purpose of introducing Superintendent Dr. Christina Kishimoto to their communities, share views on public education, and discuss the community’s role in supporting student achievement.

The first September community meeting in held for this purpose occurred in the City and County of Honolulu on September 12, 2017 at the Leilehua High School library (located at 1515 California Avenue, Wahiawa, Hawaii). The meeting was hosted by Board Member Hubert Minn. There were approximately 75 attendees, which included Superintendent Kishimoto, school administrators, Department staff, teachers, administrators, parents, and community members.

The second September community meeting occurred in Hawaii County on September 18, 2017 at the Kealakehe High School library (located at 74-500 Puohulihuli Street, Kailua-Kona, Hawaii). The meeting was hosted by Board Member Pat Bergin. There were approximately 65 attendees, which included Superintendent Kishimoto, Complex Area Superintendent Art Souza (Honokaa-Kealakehe-Kohala-Konawaena), Department staff, school administrators, teachers, parents, and community members.

The third September community meeting occurred in Maui County on September 29, 2017 at the Pōmaika’i Elementary School library (located at 4650 South Kamehameha Avenue, Kahului, Hawaii). The meeting was hosted by Board Members Kili Namau’u and Bruce Voss. The meeting did not occur as of the time of this writing, so Board Members will provide an oral report at the meeting.
