# Overview of Project

- \$8,219,659 for fiscal year 2013-2014, for the Department to undertake a 1:1 digital device per student pilot.
- Focus
  - Digital Curriculum
  - Mastery of the Common Core State Standards
  - Impact of technology



# Overview of Budget

- Total budget of \$8,219,659

## Assumptions

- \$25/per student set aside to support curriculum purchase
- Not creating new positions
- Purchasing devices as opposed to leasing

# Overview of Implementation Strategy

- Selecting schools based on criteria for success
  - Infrastructure
  - Built in IT support
  - Staff readiness
- Deploying teacher devices first semester and student devices second semester (with exceptions).
- Targeted, hands on PD that integrates curriculum, instruction, assessment, and technology.
