1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

At the December 16, 2021 Board of Education General Business Meeting (GBM), there were 395 new confirmed and probable infections of COVID-19 cases reported statewide and 41 cases reported at the schools. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), along with the medical community, were monitoring the Omicron variant and assessing its potential impacts on communities and the economy.

Since students and staff returned to school campuses on January 4, 2022, the country and state have seen a significant increase in the number of COVID-19 cases, which has caused major disruptions across the community. Working closely with the Hawaii State Department of Health (DOH), the Hawaii State Department of Education (Department) has been proactively tracking and monitoring the reports and data to make necessary adjustments to school operations for the health and safety of our students and staff.

The Department has continued to make significant efforts to keep staff and students safe while keeping school facilities open given the benefits of in-person education. The Department's COVID-19 Health and Safety Guidance for School Year 2021-2022 has been recently updated with new information provided by the DOH and the CDC. Additionally, vaccination and testing opportunities for our students and employees are ongoing through

the Department’s close collaboration with the DOH to further support the health and well-being of school communities.

2. DESCRIPTION

This presentation provides an update to the data and information requested in the “Presentation on COVID-19 Update for the 2021-2022 school year” at the December 16, 2021 GBM as referenced through the following webpage:

1. **Data on positive student and staff cases:**

As of July 7, 2021, the Department is required to publicly report the following information on COVID-19 positive test results: School names, date the COVID-19 positive test result was reported to the school, and the date that the positively tested student, staff, or affiliated individual was last on a school campus. The data are not disaggregated by students, staff, or affiliated individuals.

**2. Staff and student attendance rates:**

**a. Percentage of students absent by school and complex.**

On September 15, 2021, the Department released revised School Attendance Procedures, which include standardized attendance-taking policy, operational procedures, and accountability updates. Elementary and secondary schools are expected to adhere to these procedures for taking and reporting daily attendance. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, these procedures have been expanded to fit the in-person and virtual environments.

The Department reports the percentage of students present and defines Average Daily Attendance as the total days of student attendance divided by the total days of instruction.

**3. Status of school-hosted vaccination sites:**

**a. Percentage of schools that hosted a vaccination site out of the total number that expressed an interest in hosting a site.**

In partnership with the DOH, 100% of the schools that have expressed an interest in hosting a vaccination clinic have had the opportunity to host. Between May 2021 to January 11, 2022, 535 public school-based clinics were completed. Department personnel also worked closely with specific community-based vaccination clinics to provide access to the vaccinations for students and families. All vaccination sites are staffed by medical personnel from a health provider.

**b. Number of people vaccinated at school-hosted vaccination sites. Disaggregate the data by student, staff, and public.**

Disaggregated information regarding the role groups of students, staff, and public vaccinated through school-based vaccination sites is captured from the DOH.

The total doses administered through the Department’s school-based vaccination events as of January 11, 2022 is 31,375 doses administered to students 12 and older, staff, and family and community members.

**4. Status of school-based COVID-19 testing:**

**a. Percentage of schools, by complex, that provide regular, on-campus testing.**

DOH defines regular testing as tested within the previous week. They recommend testing weekly and using the previous week as the time frame allows for a cleaner and more consistent measure.

The data below contains the number and percentage of schools by complex area that have hosted testing during the week of January 2, 2022.

**b. Level of access to school-based testing sites (limited to school, open to area schools, etc.).**

Access to testing for students and employees is available through multiple partnerships. Depending on the hours of operation, schools can choose to have the sites open during and after school hours. In most cases, sites operated during school hours and were specifically designed for students and employees of the school. For afterschool operations, depending on the facilities, a single site can offer testing for multiple schools and other members of the household. As designated by the federal funding, priority is given to students and then employees.

**c. Types of tests offered at school-based testing sites.**

Depending on the type of testing opportunity, the school sites are utilizing rapid-antigen tests or Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) tests.

**d. Update on turnaround time for testing results for tests that require laboratory processing.**

Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) analysis must be done in a Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments (CLIA)-certified laboratory. Depending on the location of the laboratory, the turnaround time for results is approximately 48 hours. Rapid antigen testing results are processed on-site and take approximately 20 minutes to two hours, depending on the volume of testing to process.

**e. Update on staffing issues, including whether the creation of a new class of employees to administer tests has alleviated staffing issues.**

The Department continues to work with schools and offices with their shortage areas to determine appropriate options to address their staffing needs.

Beginning October 5, 2021, in response to the COVID-19 pandemic and to address students' health and safety needs, complex areas and schools were provided an option to establish community relations program assistant positions to support their COVID-19 testing and mitigation efforts as needed. To date, two positions were established – one at the school level and one at the complex area level.

Complex Area Superintendents and school principals may use the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) funds they received to hire additional staff as needed.

**f. Plans for expanding testing availability.**

Beginning January 3, 2022, new Oahu sites were opened through a DOH contract with CVS. More parents are consenting to test their children and current testing schools can increase testing supplies for their sites through work orders. Schools interested in testing can register with the DOH to set up a testing clinic.

**g. Update on the distribution of at-home testing kits.**

The current national supply of at-home testing kits is limited. However, the federal government has shared plans to distribute a limited supply of BinaxNOW point-of-care antigen tests to maintain in-person education. These additional tests will help support schools using or ready to implement point-of-care rapid antigen tests that need additional test kits. The Department has made a request to access the rapid antigen tests for all public schools statewide.

The Department is also continuing to research suppliers that can provide large quantities of the acceptable test types as described by the DOH. The Department will utilize additional funds to purchase additional testing kits.

**h. Whether Department plans to institute test-to-stay protocols.**

At this time, there is a pause to test-to-stay protocols due to the lack of availability of testing supplies for the State of Hawaii. Discussions regarding test-to-stay are ongoing; however, the new guidelines for quarantine and isolation were changed on January 10, 2022, and these new guidelines would have yielded the same reduction in the number of quarantine or isolation days.

**5. Department employee and student vaccination rates:**

- a. Number of fully vaccinated Department employees and percentage of total Department workforce.**

- c. Percentage of fully vaccinated students.**

The Department does not collect this information.

- d. Plans to collect information on Department employees who receive booster shots.**

As of January 10, 2022, the Department has begun collecting and verifying COVID-19 booster vaccination data through its electronic human resource system (eHR). In accordance with guidance from the DOH and the CDC, COVID-19 boosters are not required at this time to be considered fully vaccinated, however, booster status does impact recommended quarantine periods for individuals who test positive or have been in close contact.

- e. Data relating to Department actions taken against employees for non-compliance with vaccine and testing requirements.**

There have been 14 salaried employees that the Department has taken action against for non-compliance with vaccine and testing requirements. This equates to 0.0006% of all Department salaried employees.

**6. Status of various Department workforce shortages:**

**a. Data on significant Department workforce shortage areas, including, but not limited to teachers, substitutes, school staff, and bus drivers.**

**Teachers:**

There has been no significant change in the percentage of teacher positions filled since the December 16, 2021 GBM. Schools are still able to contract new teachers up to 90 calendar days from the teachers' last workday of the school year or track. At the completion of the school year 2021-2022, the Department anticipates the fill rate for teacher positions to remain above 90%, as in past school years.

**Classified:**

Since the December Board meeting, there have been no significant changes in the types of classified positions that were reported as shortage areas. The tables below provide a quick summary.

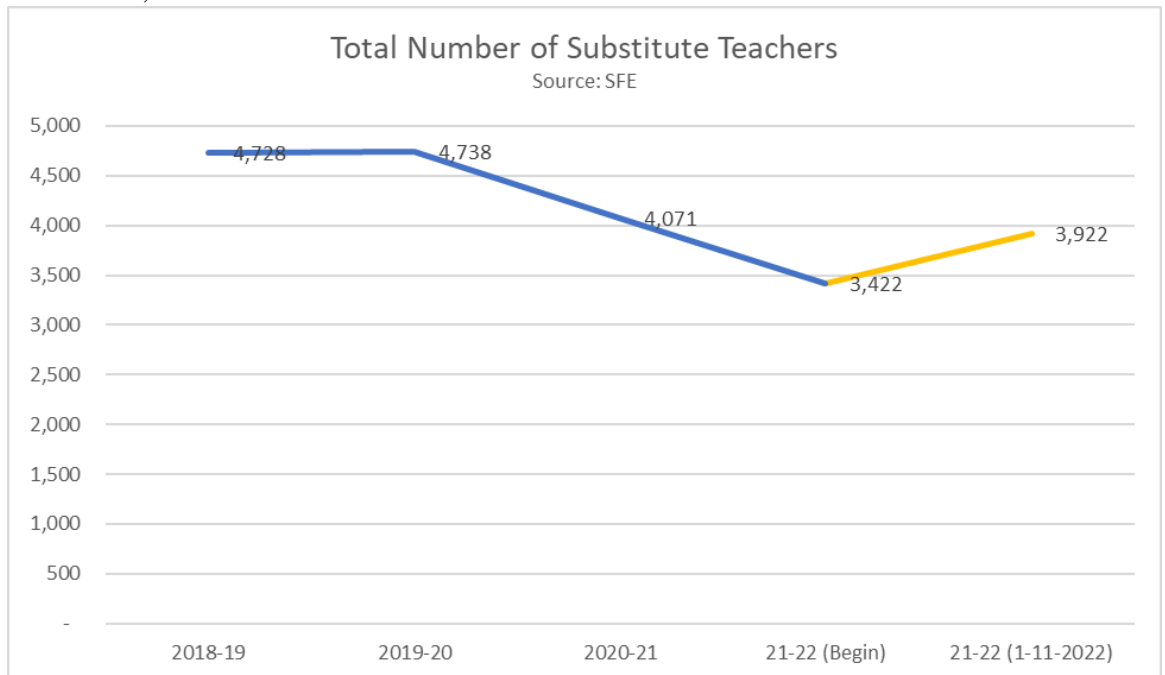

**b. Results of efforts to alleviate shortages, including recent events to recruit employees, part-time temporary employees, and substitutes.**

**Teacher Recruitment Updates:**

**Statistics:**

1. School Year 2021-2022 Teacher Hiring - 1,277 educators hired (181 additional hires in comparison to 1,096 from the 12/16/21 report).
2. A total of 1,585 State Approved Teacher Education Program (SATEP) educators remain in the pool eligible to be hired (128 added since 12/16/21 report).

**Strategies to Engage Applicant Pool & Prospective Applicants:**

The Department has initiated a rebranding of the teacher recruitment website, [www.teachinhawaii.org](http://www.teachinhawaii.org), which has seen 3,500 unique users since the report to the GBM on December 16, 2021. Additionally, two targeted email blasts to priority hiring areas (Pacific and NorthEast) on December 22 and 29, 2021 yielded 133 new applications (128 SATEP applicants; 5 applicants without a teacher education program completed) and significant website traffic.

The Department recruited four new Teacher of the Year “Aloha Ambassadors” in partnership with the Office of Talent Management’s Leadership Institute. These Aloha Ambassadors have led weekly webinars on the application and hiring process for Department positions and provided advice on living and working in the islands.

The Department also conducted a virtual hiring fair on December 9, 2021, where 40 schools statewide participated and saw the hiring of 16 teachers. Additional efforts will be made at the following three upcoming job fairs:

**Substitute Teacher Recruitment Updates:**

The Department is working on a substitute teacher survey to gather quantitative data on aspects such as working conditions and compensation. The Department anticipates the survey to be released before the end of the month. This data will assist in determining short and long-term solutions to addressing substitute teacher shortages statewide.

**c. Number of unfilled substitute teacher job requests disaggregated by complex area.**

The data below indicates the number of unfilled substitute job requests by complex area that went unfilled during the current third quarter of the school year 2021-2022 because there was no substitute teacher available to fulfill the request. This data is a compilation of absences for the third quarter (January 3-11, 2022) and varies on a daily basis.

**7. Supports for students:**

- a. State office guidance to schools about supports schools need to provide to**

**students that have to quarantine or isolate.**

When students are in quarantine or isolation, work packets or distance learning options are provided to students as appropriate.

**b. State office guidance to schools about supports schools need to provide to students when teachers are out sick or need to quarantine or isolate.**

Schools secure substitute teachers when a teacher is out sick or in quarantine or isolation.

**8. Masking requirements:**

**a. Whether students, staff, and visitors need to wear masks outside when on school campuses.**

Masks must be worn by everyone – students, staff, visitors and contracted service providers – while on a Department school campus or facility when indoors and outdoors.

**b. How the state office and complex areas provide support to schools to implement and enforce masking requirements.**

Masks are included in the inventory of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) that each school maintains in order to support the safety of schools. Schools are provided with guidance and PPE inventory to implement the masking requirements.

Additionally, the state office provides the following:

1. PPE supplies are managed, monitored and resupplied by the state office. The Department tracks use rates and supplies each school and state office with inventory from various sources. The Department also researches the best value and uses various PPE suppliers when certain types of PPE are not available from vendors.
2. Management of enforcement at the school level is handled by the school staff. Principals, vice principals, teachers and support staff play a vital role in working together with students in the management of proper mask use.
3. Management of PPE's for health, administrative, and district offices are also supported by state offices.
4. State offices developed a monitoring system to observe inventory issues where use rates are higher and need more frequent replenishment. Each school or

location has a running inventory of 90 days. As inventory changes and schools or offices report to the online monitoring system, state offices respond and resupply.

5. State office maintains a number of PPE supplies for immediate resupply needs. This is a standing three-day supply.
6. The Department ensures increased inventory for Hana, Lanai, and Molokai as the delivery frequency is less accessible. Thus, this provides a greater supply for the locations that are more difficult to serve.
7. The Department works with the Hawaii Emergency Management Agency (HiEMA) for allowable reimbursements of PPE supplies.

**c. How the state office and complex areas communicate masking requirements to schools.**

Masking requirements are described in the Department's *COVID-19 Health & Safety Guidance* and published on the Department's website at [www.hawaiipublicschools.org](http://www.hawaiipublicschools.org). State offices, complex areas, and school principals are notified by email when the Guidance is updated to align with new information from the DOH or CDC.

**9. Supports for school safety protocols:**

**a. Description of the supports provided to all schools by the state office and complex areas to implement safety protocols.**

Complex area and school level COVID-19 Response Positions were established on October 5, 2021. Schools and complex areas may utilize these newly created positions to support COVID-19 testing and mitigation efforts.

The Department continued the funding of 14 Nurse Practitioners, 15 Hawaii Keiki Registered Nurses (RN), and the Telehealth Hotline from General Funds for the 2021-2022 School Year. Additional funding from DOH and ESSER grants are being utilized to ensure each Complex Area has a Hawaii Keiki Nurse Practitioner, a Hawaii Keiki RN in all 41 Complexes for the full year (12-month positions), additional Behavioral Health support, and a Hawaii Keiki School Health Support Staff (SHSS) for all 257 schools. To date, Hawaii Keiki has 44 out of 56 nursing (RN and nurse practitioner) positions filled with an additional 8 RNs committed to starting in the next six weeks.

The 257 SHSS positions are designed to manage testing programs and support schools with COVID-19 duties. These SHSS positions, when filled, will be

supervised by the Hawaii Keiki RNs. Recruiting efforts began on January 1, 2022, interviews are underway, and the Department anticipates the first applicants will be onboard in February. To date, the current number of applicants for these positions are: Oahu-70 applicants; Maui-7 applicants; Big Island-27 applicants; Kauai-2 applicants.
