

Problem Nationally



- National Institute for Health (NIH) show that undetected and untreated eye disorders can result in delayed reading and poorer outcomes for children in school.
- NIH reports that 25% of children aged 5-17 years have a vision problem and that 35% of school-age children have never seen an eye care professional.
- Nationwide, 22% of preschoolers receive some form of vision screening, and only 15% receive an eye exam.

Problem Locally



- Hawai'i State School Readiness Assessment (HSSRA) reported that 750 kindergarten teachers statewide has shown that only 7.3% of kindergarten classes in school year 2010 had 75% or more children consistently displaying characteristics necessary for success in school.
 - This means that for every 100 students, roughly 70% are unprepared for school.





- Over 25,000 children screened Statewide
- Nearly 10,000 screened annually
- Follow up and glasses provided to nearly 1000 children in Title 1 schools

Plus Optix Project: VISIOI




EyeSpy 2020 VisionQuest

About Vision To Learn: Founded several years ago to meet similar high rates of lack of access among low income children in Los Angeles, Vision To Learn provides free eye exams and free glasses by bringing its mobile eye clinics to schools and to other neighborhood youth and community organizations. Since 2012, Vision To Learn's trained optometrists have provided over 44,000 eye exams and over 40,000 pairs of eyeglasses to students in need.




EyeSpy 2020 Screenings
