-Private For-Profit 4-Year:	-9.3%	+ 5.3%	- 4.5%

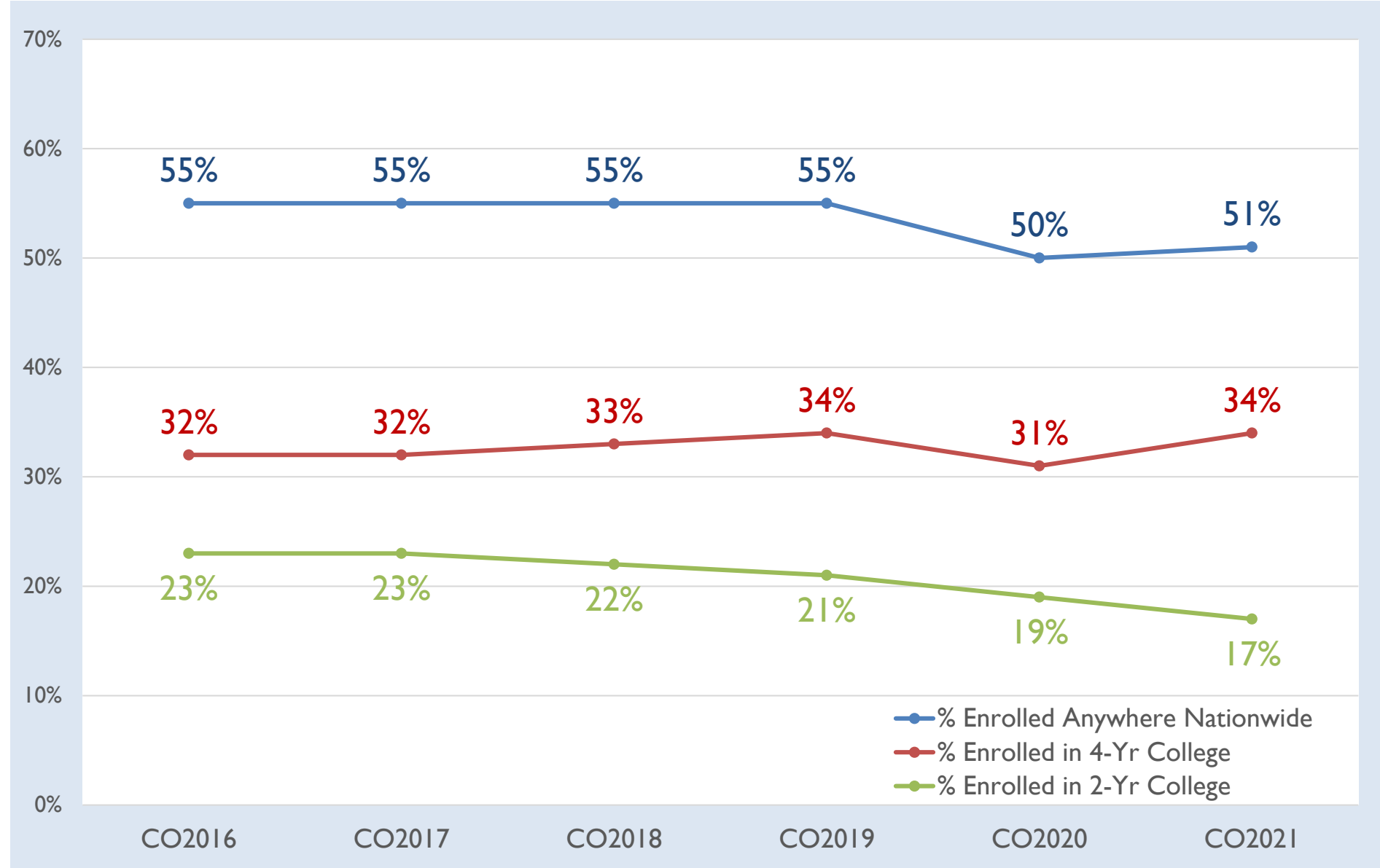
First Fall College Enrollment Increased by One Percentage Point

Enrollment Anywhere Nationwide, First Fall After Graduation



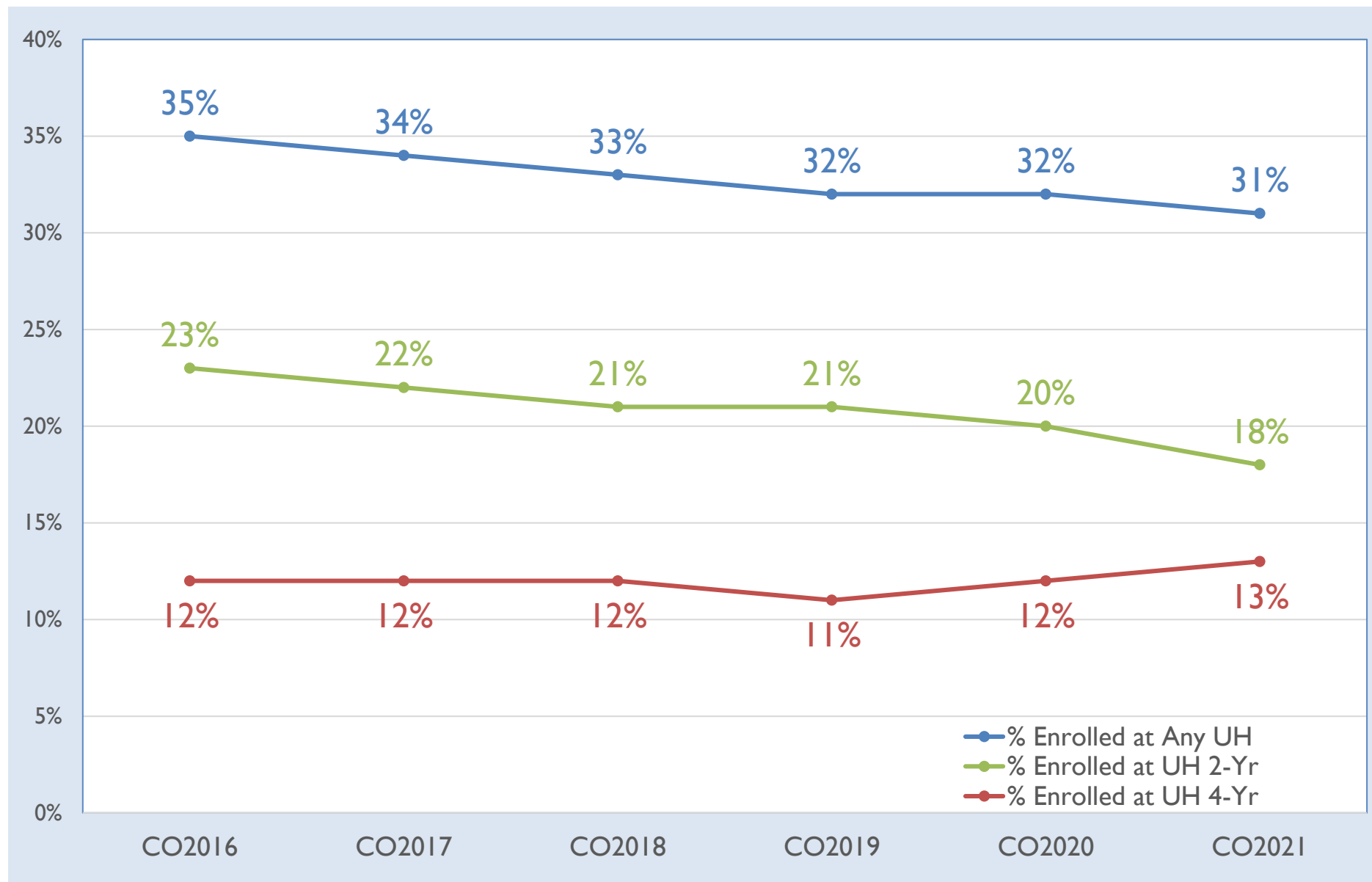

## Fall 2021 Enrollment at UH

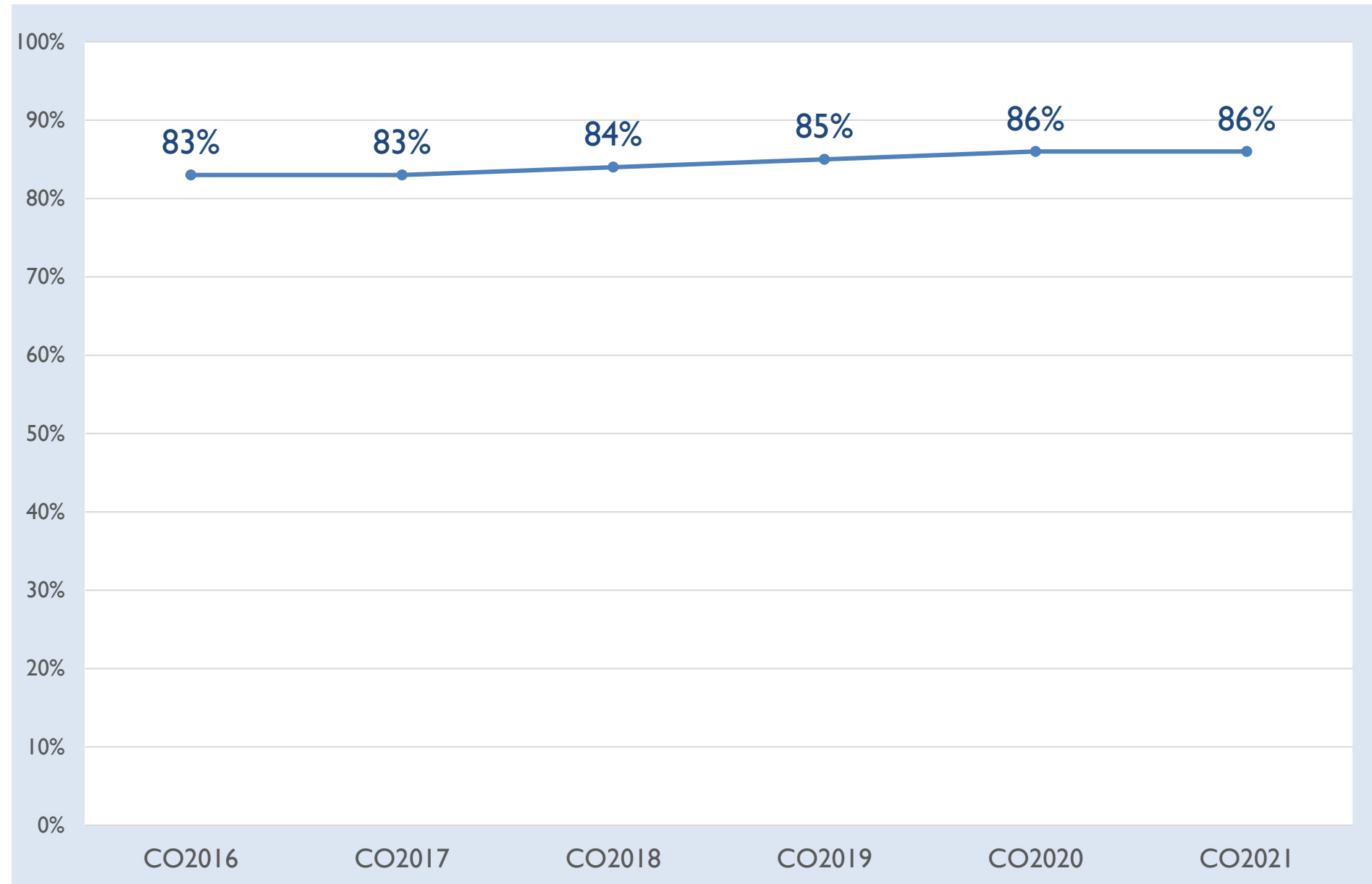
UH 2-Year vs. UH 4-Year Institutions

## On-Time Graduation Rate



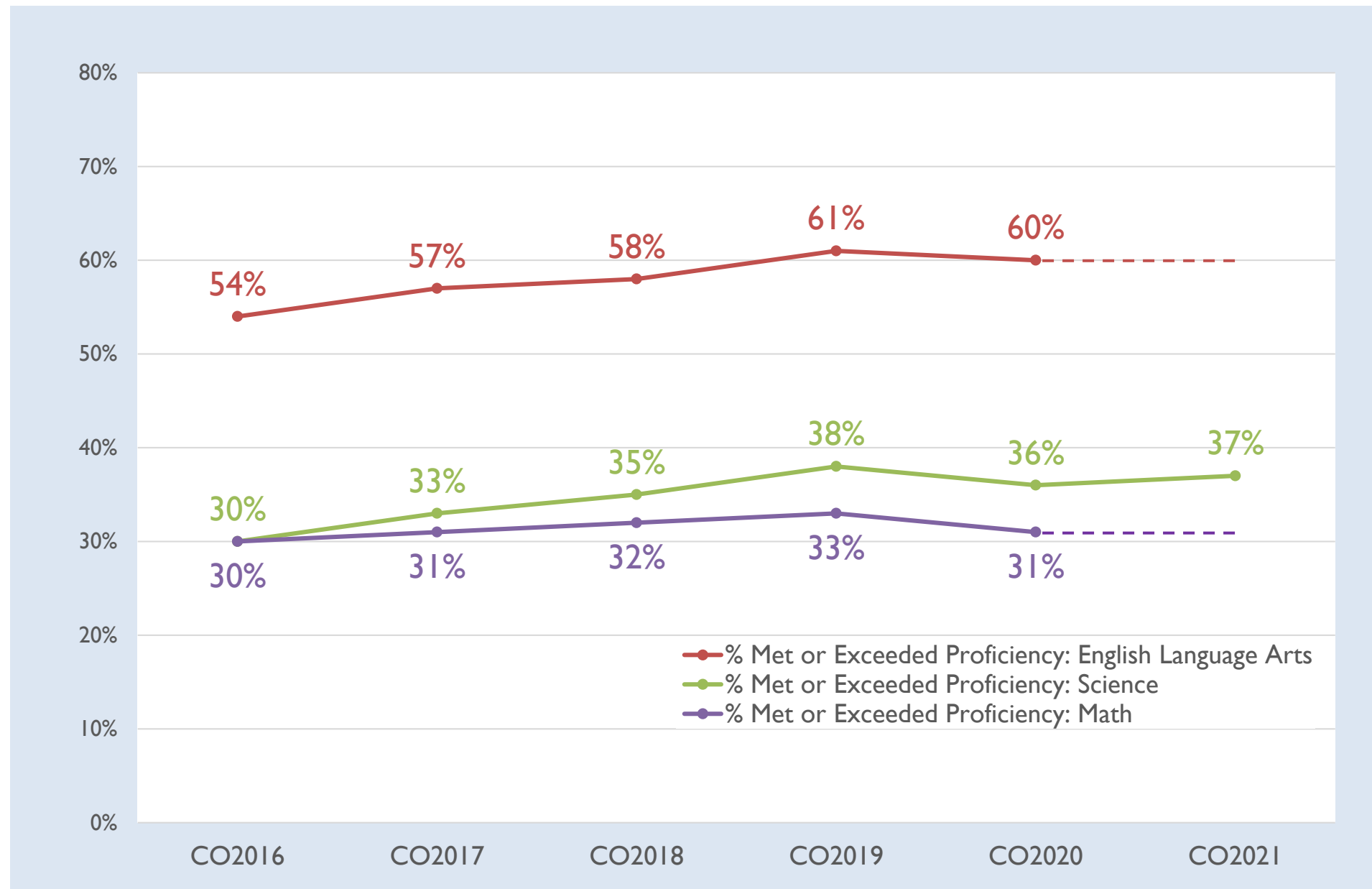
# HIDOE Class of 2021

## State Assessments: English, Math and Science

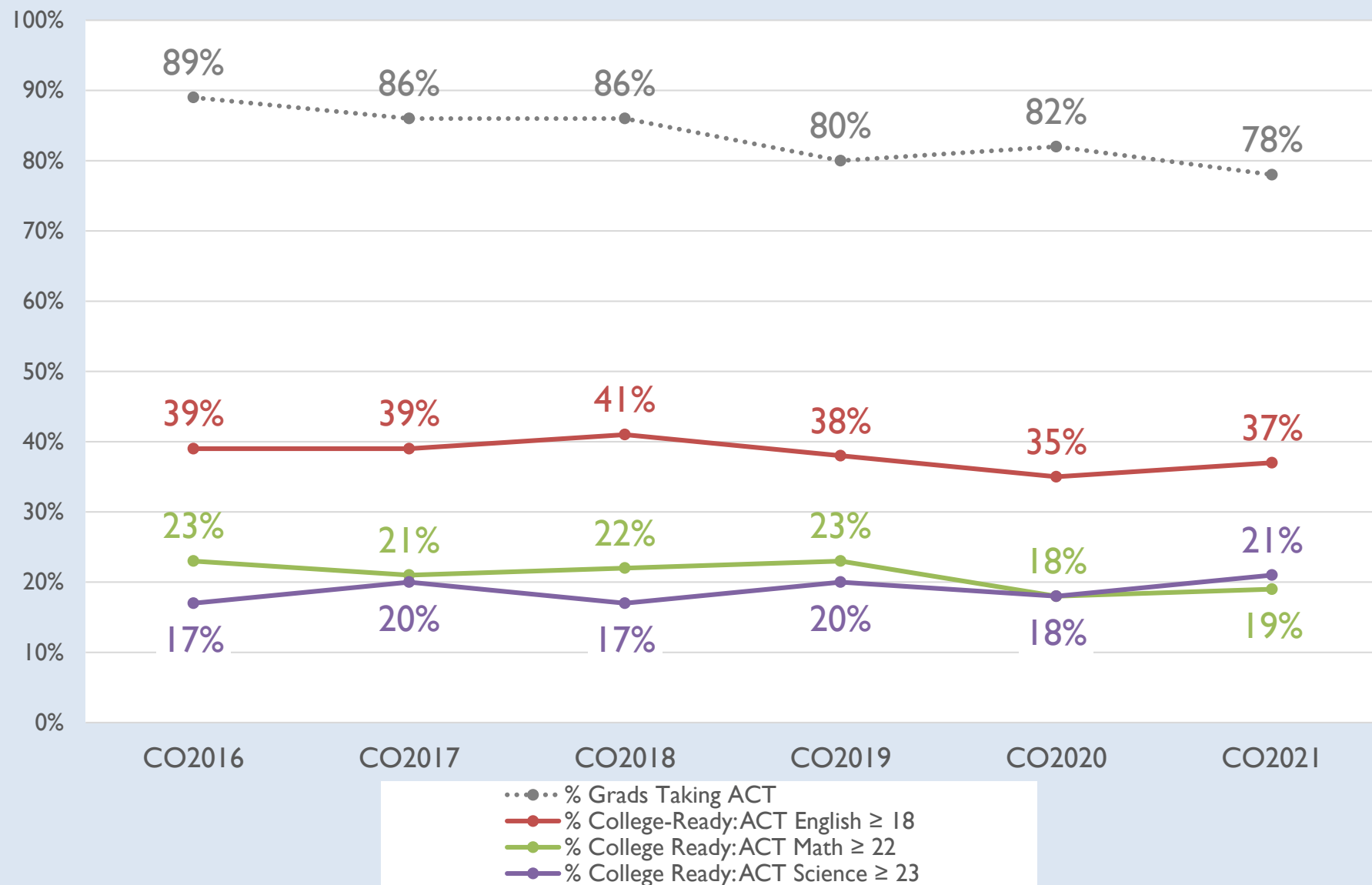


# HIDOE Class of 2021

## ACT: College Readiness Benchmarks

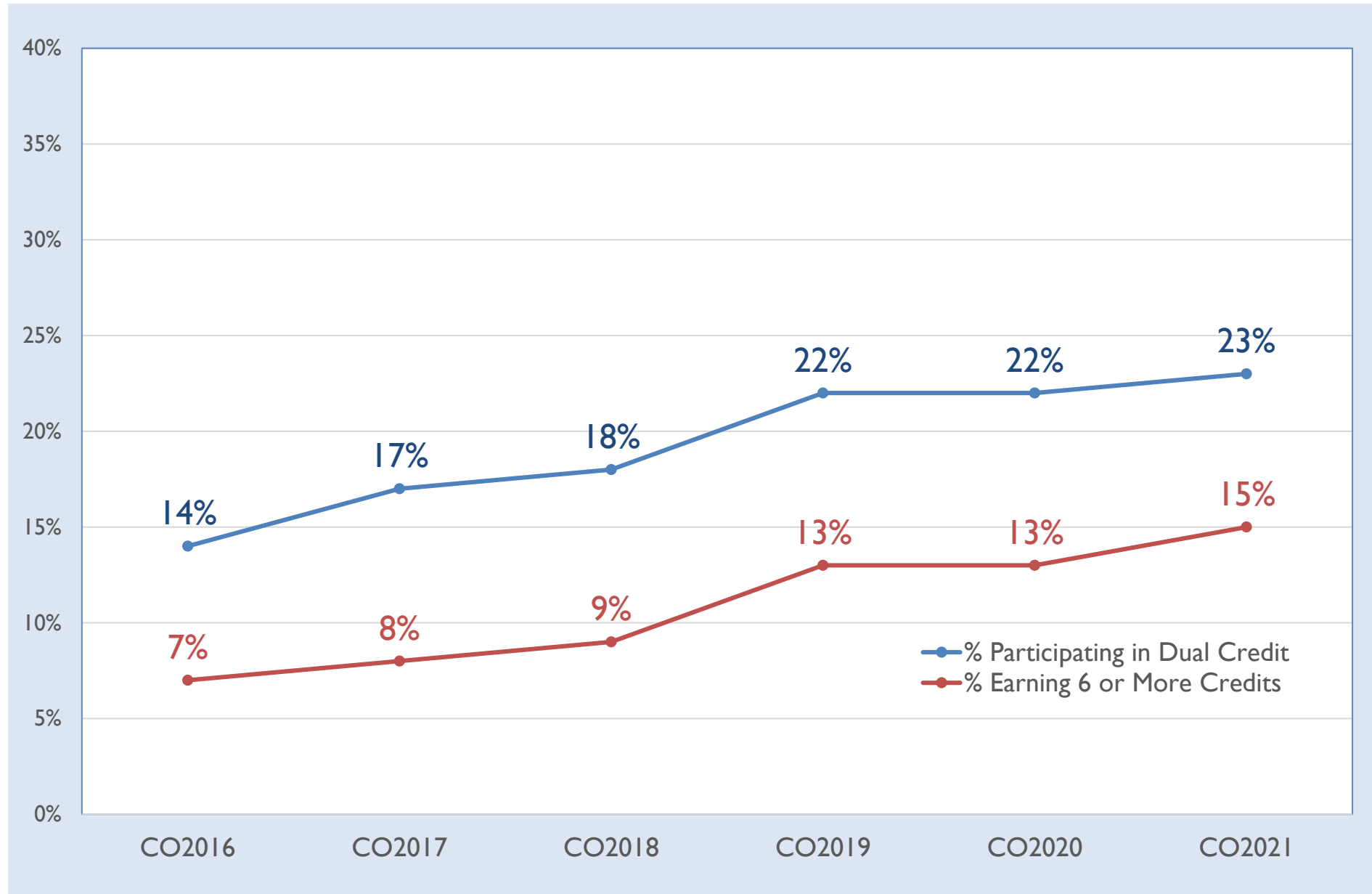

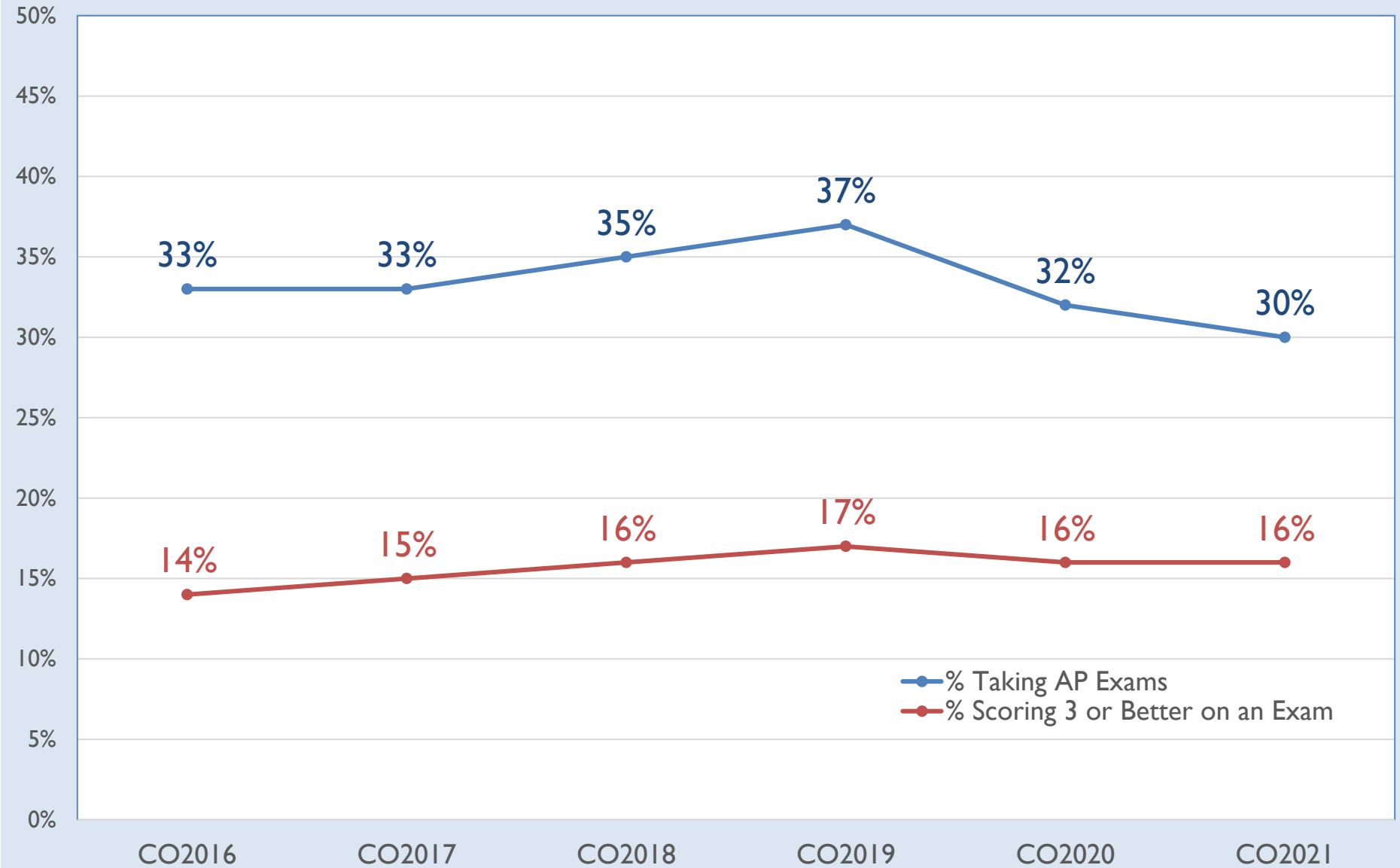

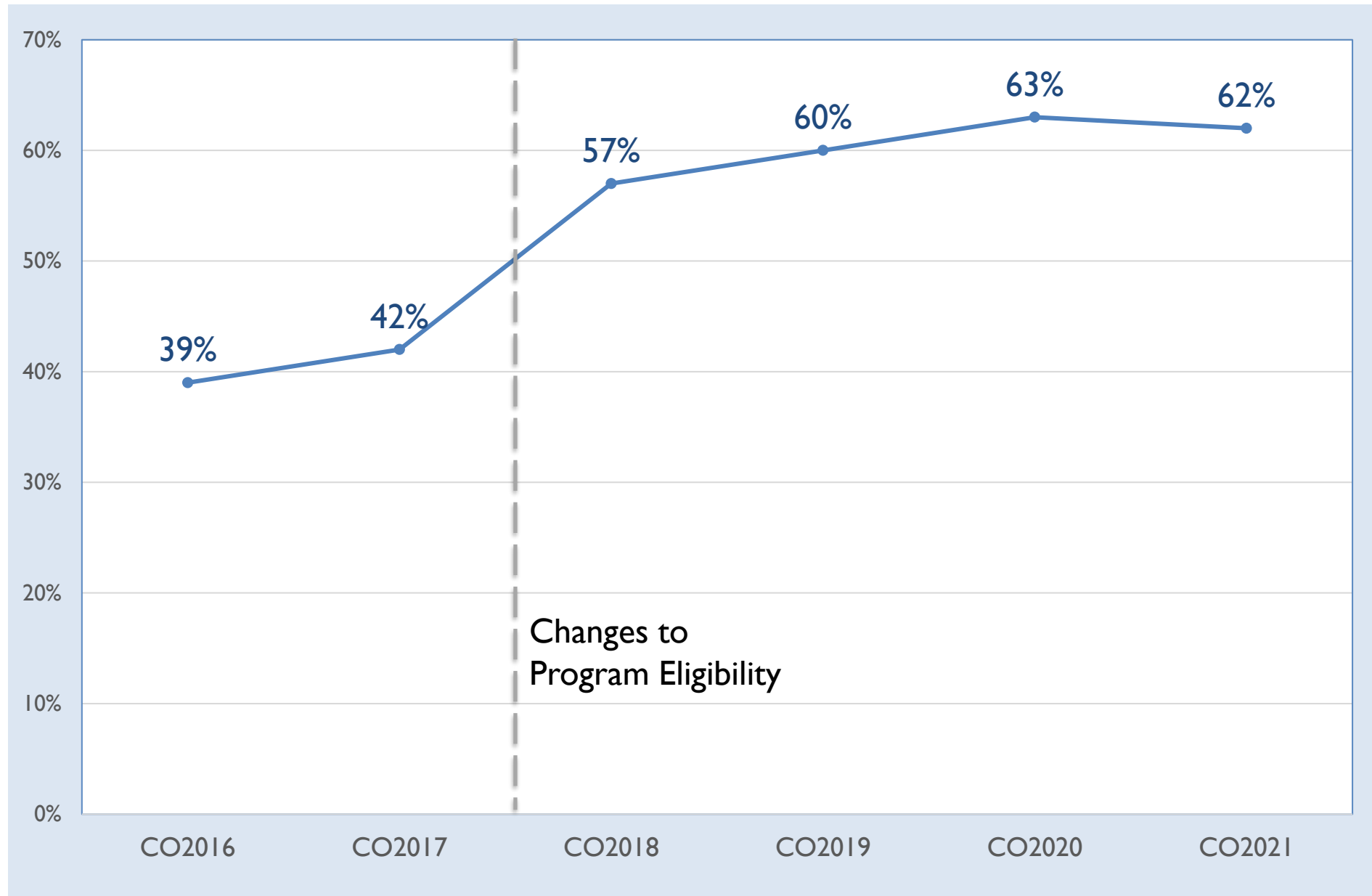

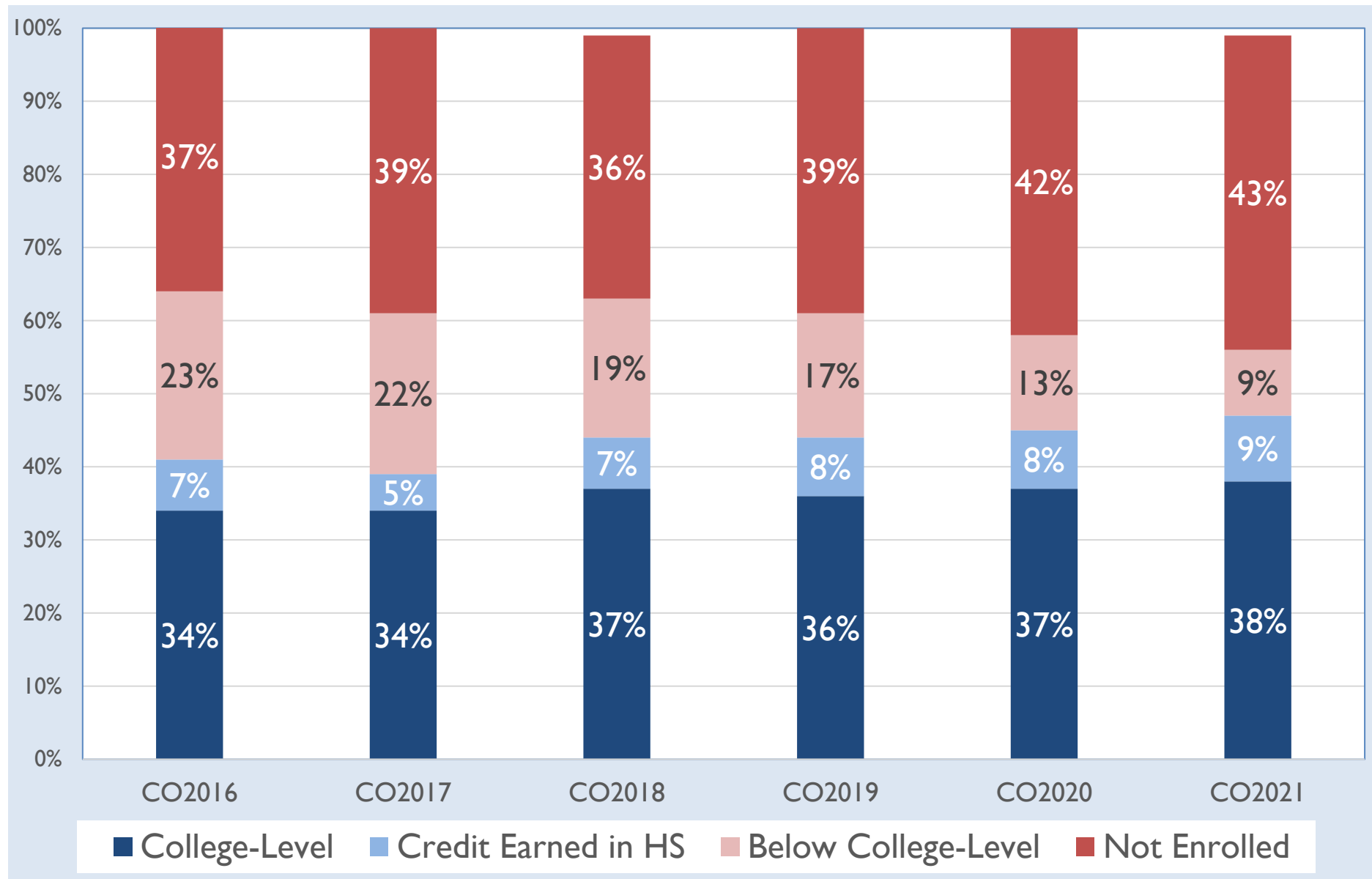

## UH Attendees: Fall College-Level Math Enrollment

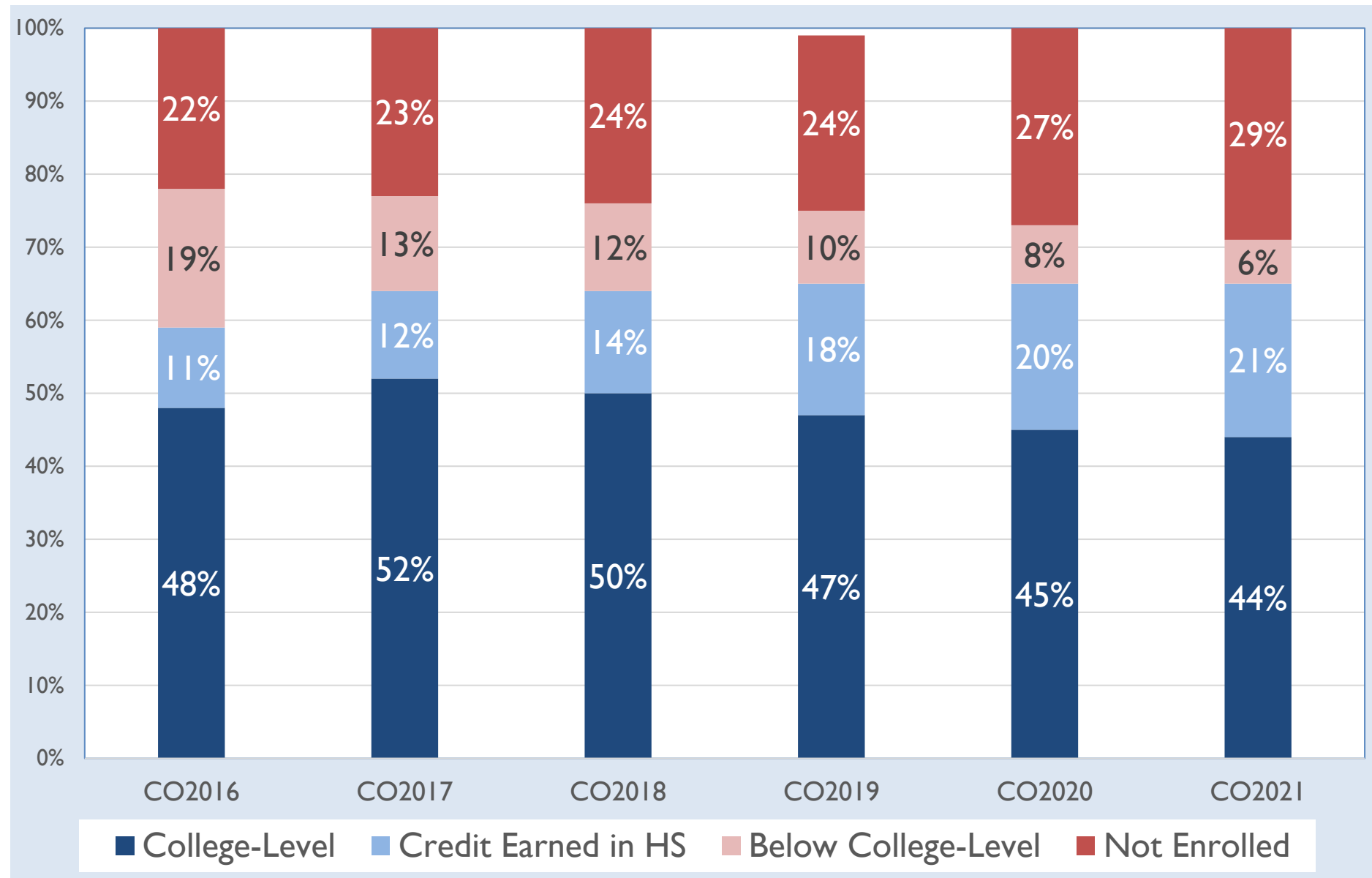

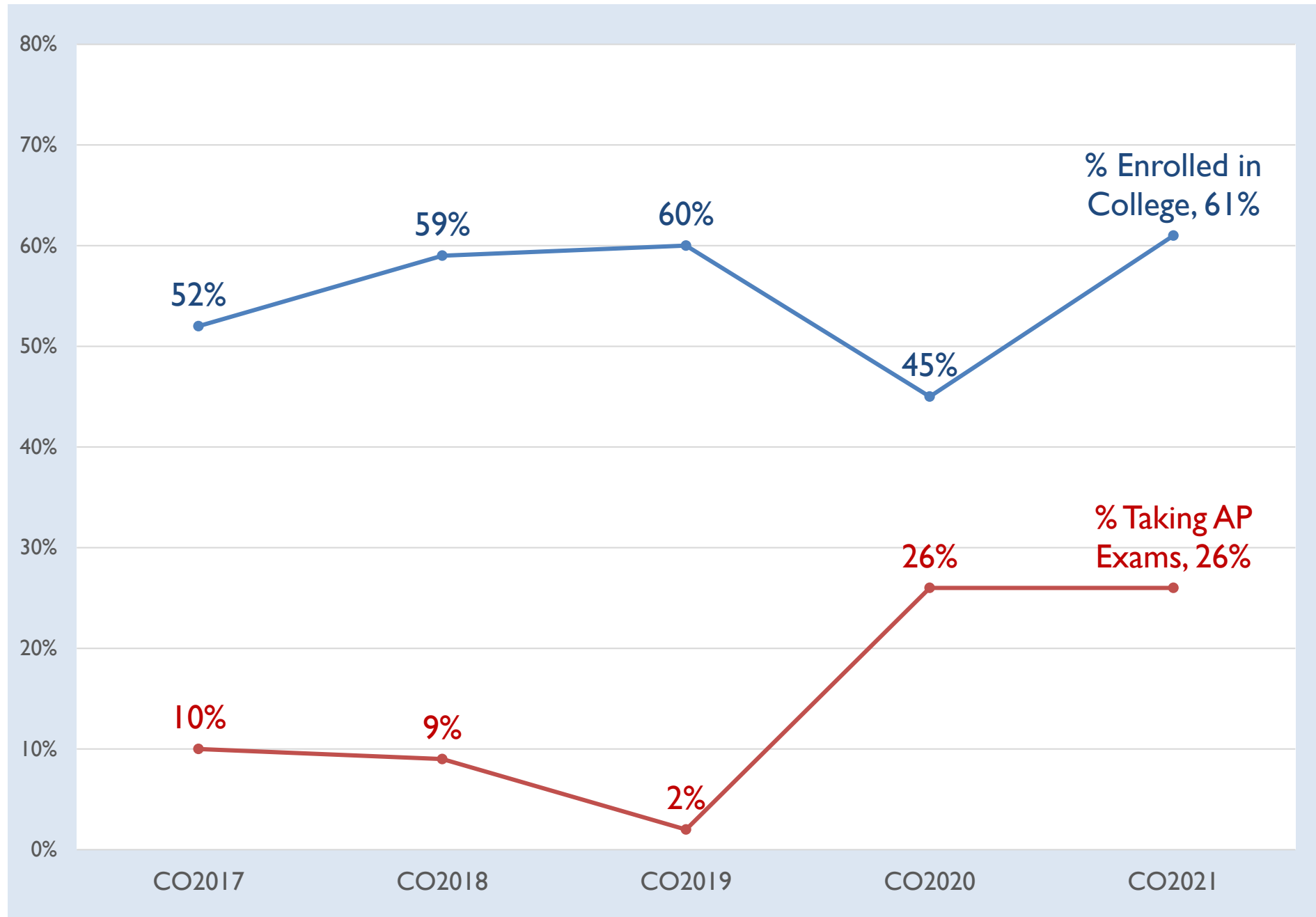
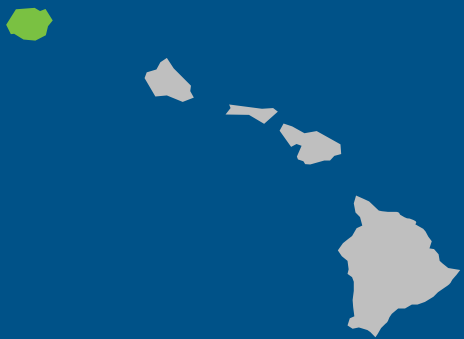

## UH Attendees: Fall College-Level English Enrollment



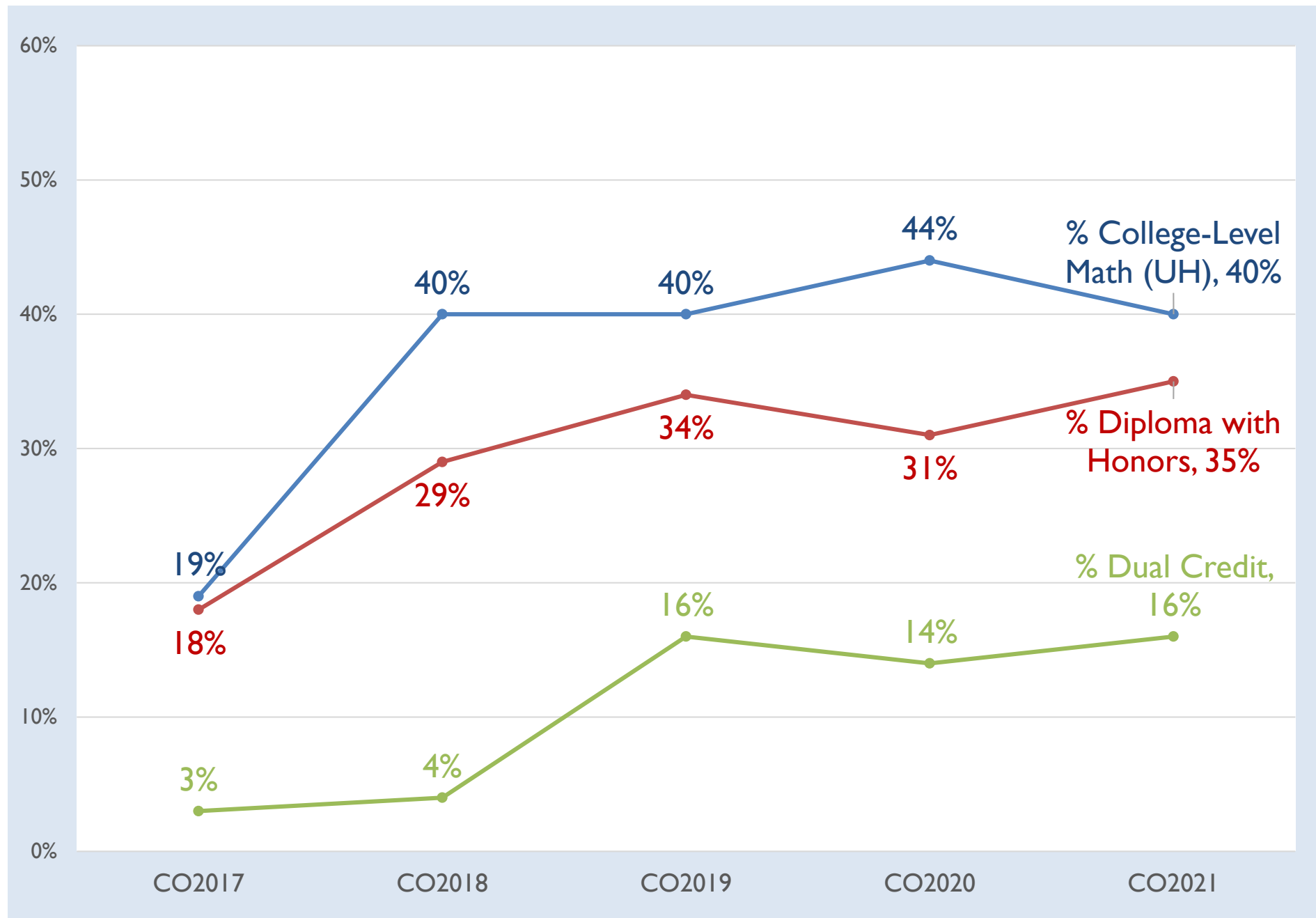

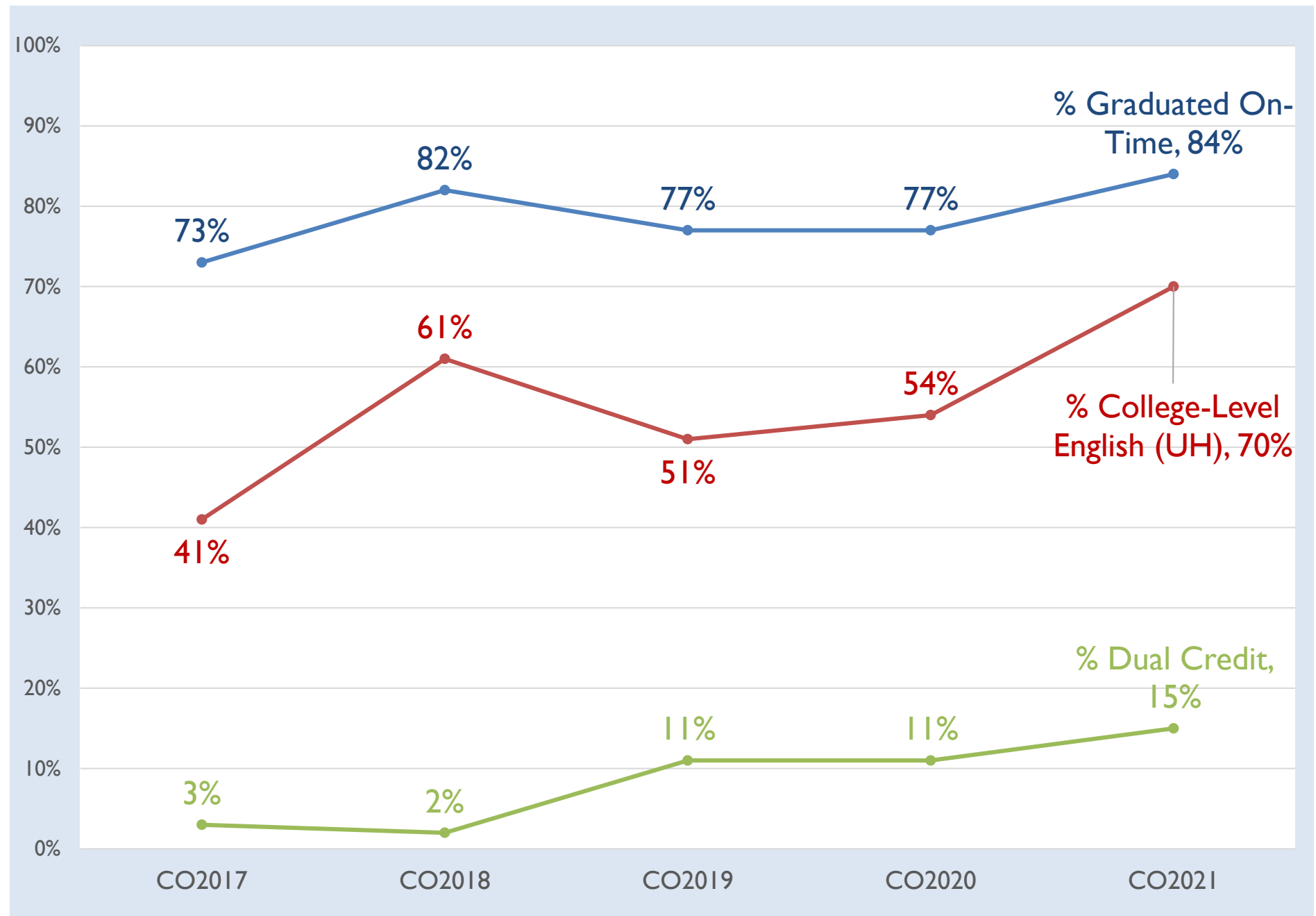

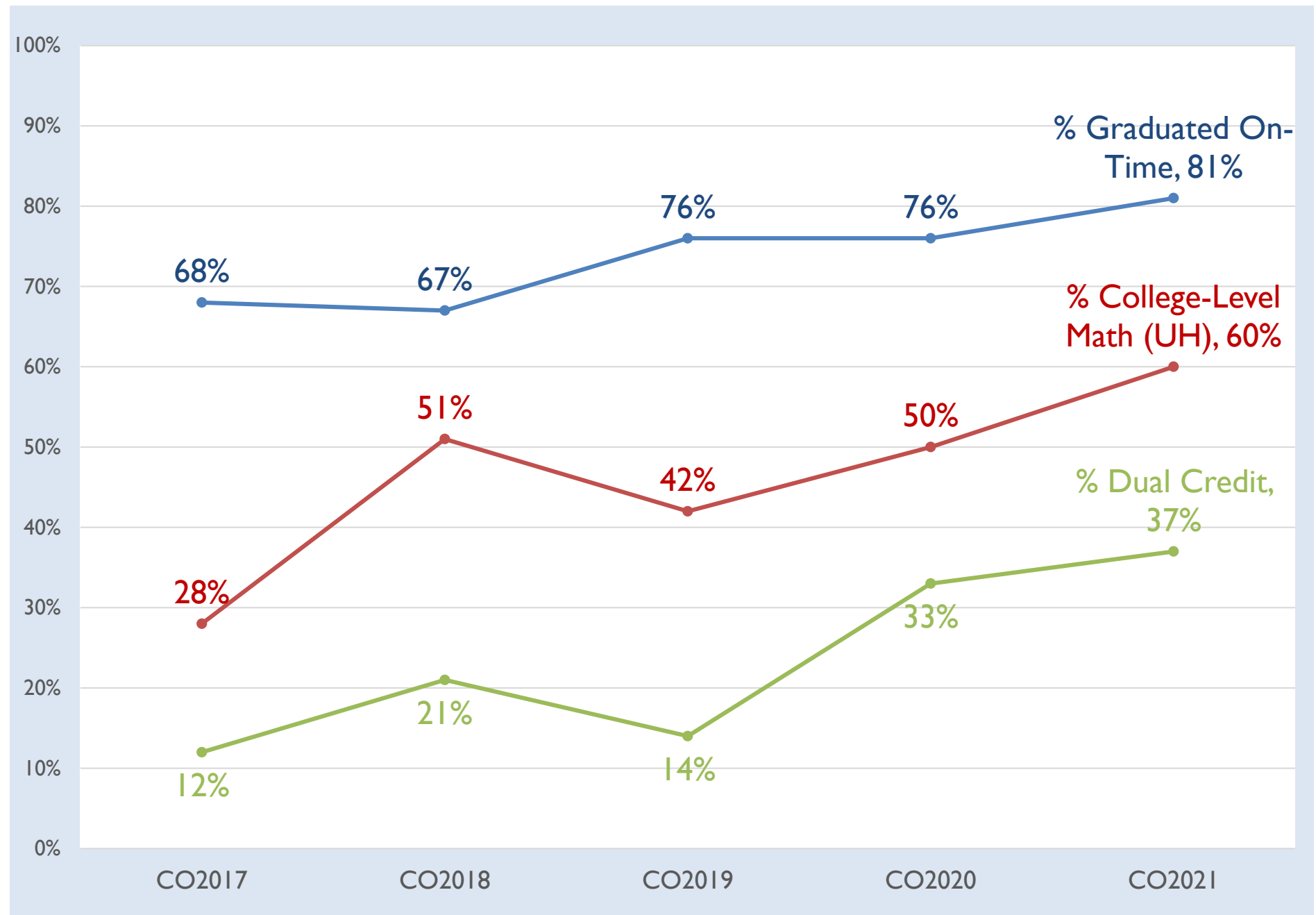
