Hawai'i Graduates for Hawai'i's Future

**GOAL
#1**

Universal access to high-quality early learning opportunities

CORE METRIC

Percentage of Hawai'i's 3- and 4-year-olds in early learning and development programs.

**GOAL
#2**

Universal preparation of every K-12 student throughout their education for college, career and citizenship

CORE METRIC

Percent of high school graduates that go on to postsecondary education, training or the military.

**GOAL
#3**

Universal access to postsecondary opportunity and success

CORE METRIC

Number of credentialed graduates from Hawai'i's postsecondary education and training programs, with equity breakdown

**GOAL
#4**

Universal education and training of Hawai'i residents to fill and create living-wage jobs available across the state

CORE METRIC

Number of living wage jobs existing and created in Hawai'i; number of living-wage job openings filled by current and returning Hawai'i residents



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Our Mission

To strengthen the education pipeline from early childhood through post secondary education and training with data informed decision making, advocacy, policy coordination, and collaborative action. Our work is focused on high expectations and equitable access, so all students can thrive in school, career and life.



What We Do

- Hawaii P-20 Council set the goal of *Hawai'i Graduates for Hawai'i's Future*, in November of 2022
 - Raise community awareness and work towards alignment with the new goal
 - Website will be launched by end of 2023 reporting on progress
- Expand the quality, access and affordability of early care and education for all keiki
 - Partnered with DOE and others to establish Hawaii State Literacy Plan, and Literacy Coalition
 - Administer federal Comprehensive Literacy Grant and Preschool Development Grant



What We Do

- Align educational direction of Hawai‘i’s education ecosystem
 - Established collaboration MOU between DOE and UH
 - Early College Strategic Directions
 - Metrics in HGHF also in UH Strategic Plan and BOE Strategic Plan
- Help high schools align programs with college and the workforce
 - Work with high schools and their college partners and industry to align programs to meet workforce needs
 - Mapping CTE programs from high school to community college and university



What We Do

- Manage data sharing among certain state agencies, and produce reporting and analysis on education data
 - Produce dashboards, data stories, and reports for the state
- Reduce barriers in the college application process for high school students
 - Implement FAST PASS to increase college-going to UH University campuses
 - Help on the ground with application events, FAFSA completion, etc.
- Pilot, scale, and sustain successful programs
 - Summer Start program for entering K students
 - Early college, including online shared courses
 - Work based learning opportunities scaling to all islands
