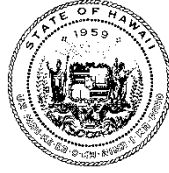

**June 30, 2023 Alternative Learning Programs, Supports & Services Summer Student Summit**

Board Member Ken Kuraya attended the Alternative Learning Programs, Supports & Services Summer Student Summit on June 30, 2023 at the University of Hawaii at Manoa Kuykendall Hall auditorium. The event showcased students in the alternative learning programs at Ka'u High, Pahoehoe High, Kealahou High and Kohala High Schools.

**July 3, 2023 Education Bill Signing Ceremony (Royal Elementary School)**

Board Chairperson Warren Haruki, Board Members Bill Arakaki and Makana McClellan attended the education bill signing ceremony on July 3, 2023 at Royal Elementary School hosted by Governor Josh Green. The measures included laws to bolster teacher housing, expand public access to early learning, increase equity and access to computer science courses for students, and establish a stipend program for preschool educators.
