

POLICY 500-9

ESTABLISHMENT OF COMPLEX AREAS

The state shall be divided for administration of the public school system into complex areas each of which shall be headed by a complex area superintendent.

Principals are accountable to complex area superintendents. Complex area superintendents are accountable to the Deputy Superintendent.

Certain functions may operate as “district” level functions, at the discretion of the Department of Education, including, but not limited to administering certain special education services.
