





Commission Initiatives: Legislative Priorities*

Adequacy and Equality of Funding Model for Charter Schools

- EDN 600 distributes funds to all schools on a per pupil basis.
- SPCSC is seeking a funding mechanism that allows to direct funding to specific teachers at specific schools for:
 - Collective Bargaining
 - Teacher Differentials

Hawai'i Keiki: Healthy & Ready to Learn Program Expansion

- Currently, only 10/38 charter schools are being served by Hawaiii Keiki nurses.
- SPCSC is seeking an additional ~\$1M to expand services to more students.


