- The Department remains focused on refining the lump sum bucket process and addressing older projects enacted by the legislature.

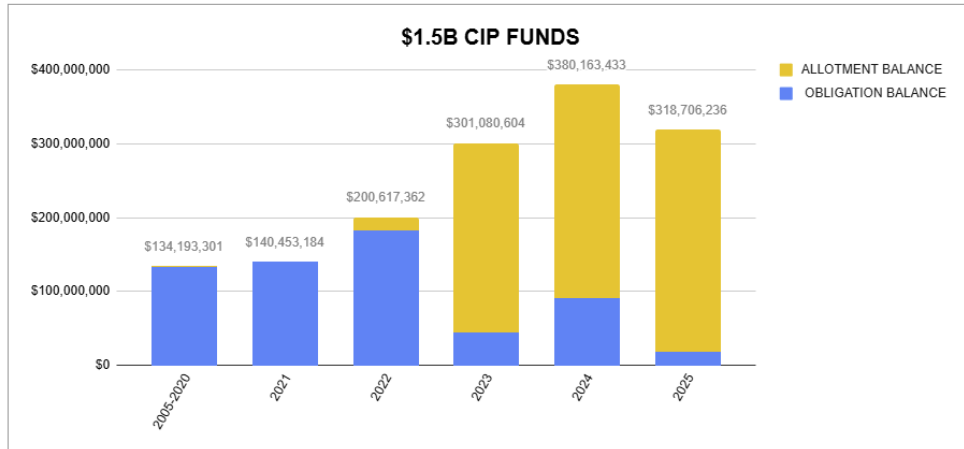

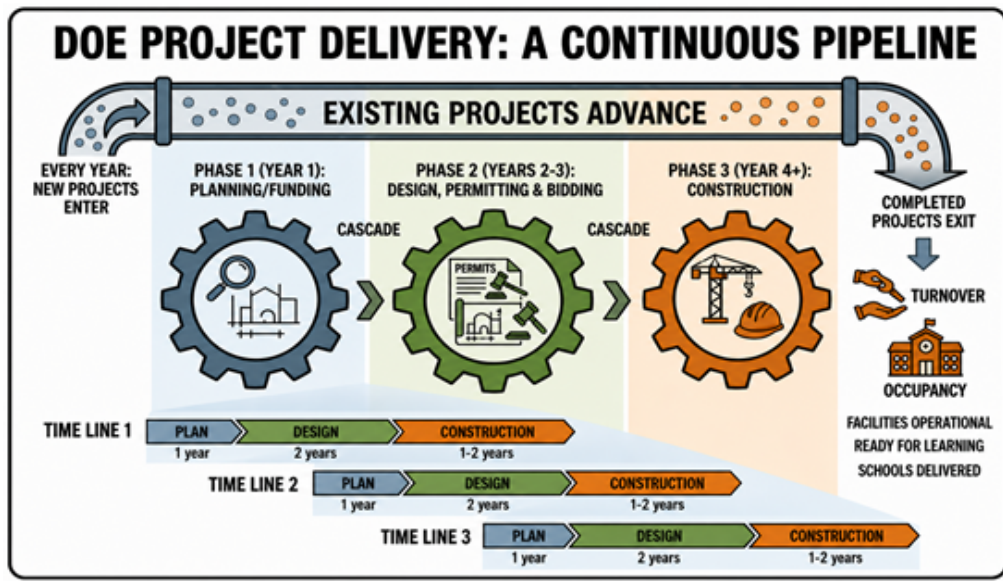
A. CIP Status

The Department's portfolio is currently valued at approximately \$1.5 billion. This value reflects previous appropriations and current financial information from Act 250, Session Laws of Hawaii 2025, as of March 24, 2026.

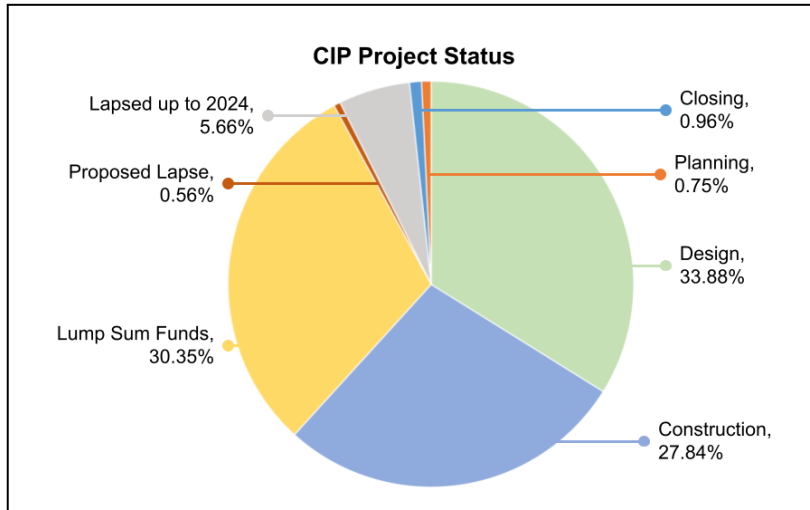
The following bar chart presents the amount of unspent CIP funds. The obligation balance represents funds that have been encumbered through contracts or purchase orders, while the allotment balance reflects funds available for consumption. A financial summary by budget fiscal year is provided in Attachment 1.



It is important to note that a \$1.5 billion portfolio size is typical for the Department, as it manages projects through a continuous overlapping process. The graphic below illustrates the CIP process as an ongoing delivery pipeline. Each year, new projects enter the pipeline, active projects progress through design and construction, and completed projects exit the pipeline. As projects move through these phases, their schedules overlap. This is a general timeline whereby some projects may take longer and others shorter, depending on the type and scope of the project.

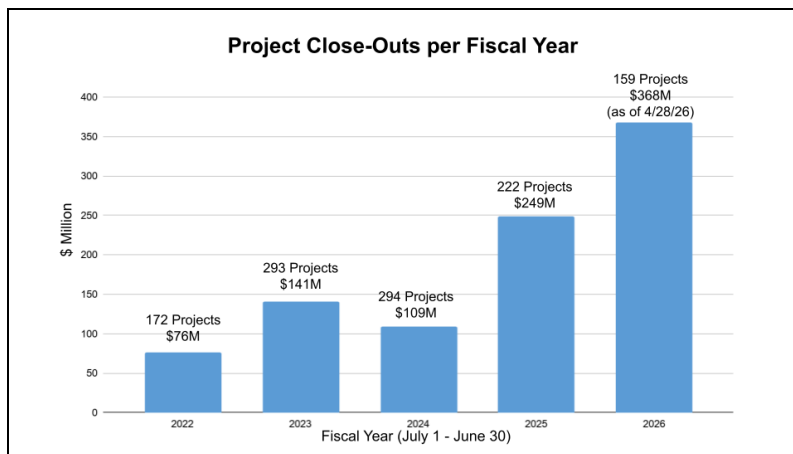


The pie chart shows a high-level view of the overall project statuses of the Department's current CIP portfolio.



**B. Construction Projects Completed (Closed)**

The following bar chart provides a historical summary of construction projects closed over the past five fiscal years.
